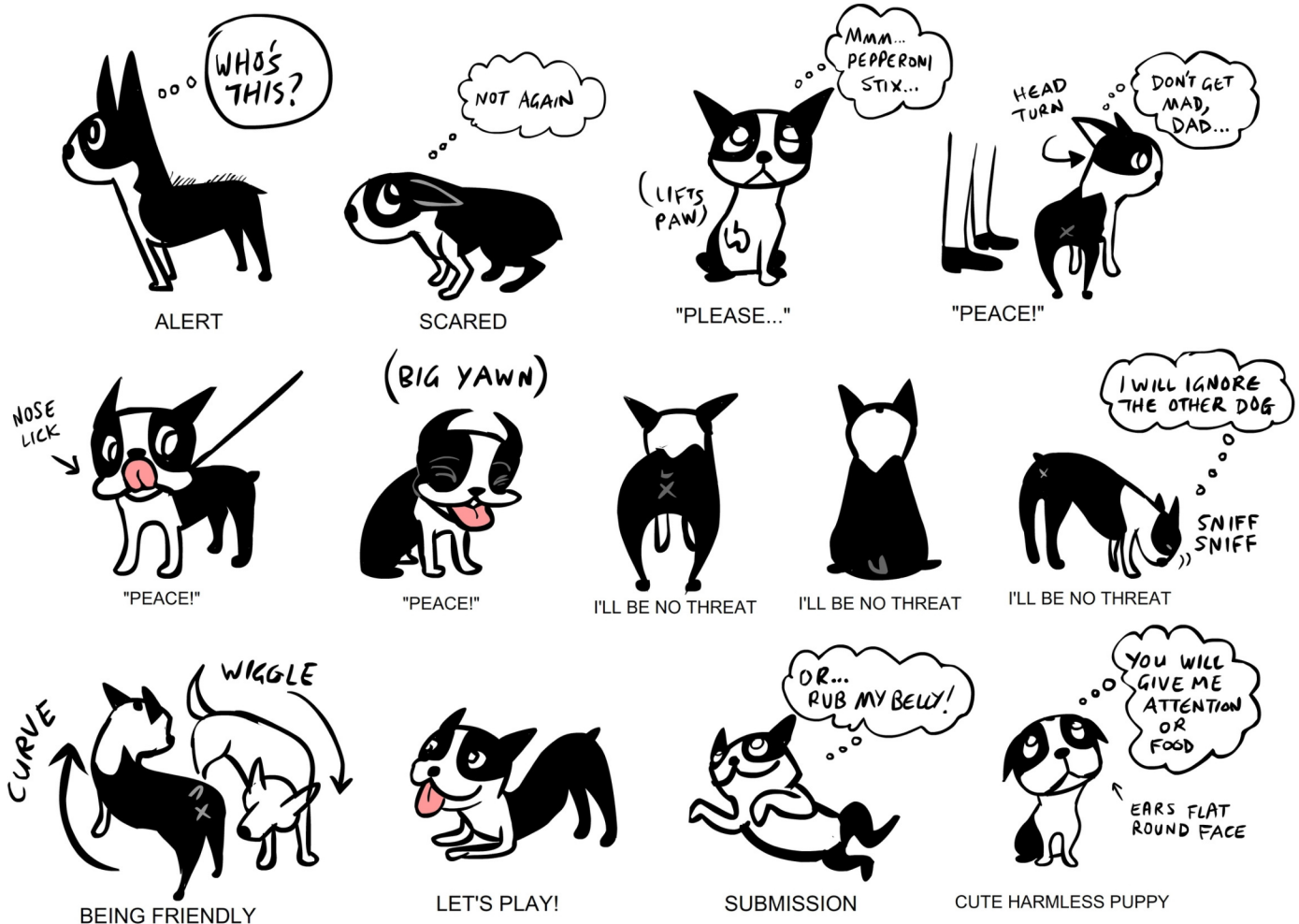


Let's talk about BODY LANGUAGE
